Health papers must be brought to the show office to pick up back numbers. (Including those 'ride-around' horses.)

Fees:

FLAT RATE - \$415/horse - includes all AQHA classes,

AQHA Fees, Office Charge and <u>ONE</u> stall. Multiple riders – multiple classes. Does <u>NOT</u> include NSBA classes, shavings, camping, Green Trail Jackpot or warm up fees.

Entry Fee: \$16/judge/class

Small Fry Fee: \$7.50/judge/class - 10 & under W/J only

Walk/trot Classes: \$10/judge/class - These are AQHA approved classes. Papers & cards required. NOTE: Per rules - If a horse-rider combination was entered into a Level 1 walk-trot class, that horse-rider combination cannot show in the corresponding loping/cantering class at that show. However, that combination can switch back and forth between the different shows

Office Charge: \$5/horse AQHA Fee: \$5/horse/judge

NSBA: \$10/class - single judged per S/C

Stalls: \$110 before August 26

\$135 after August 26

Trail Warm Up: \$10.00 per S/C Hunter Warm Ups: \$10.00 per S/C

All horses must have stalls. No jump outs are allowed. Stall assignments are made

by postmarked envelope. <u>No</u> outside shavings - All shavings must be purchased from the facility. All those wishing to be stalled together MUST send their stall reservations together. No refunds on stalls. Stall checks payable to <u>American Royal</u>.

FLAT RATE EXHIBITORS - when you send your stall check do not put it for the flat rate, just put it for your stall amount & it will be applied to your bill. Payable to American Royal.

Circuit awards in all classes. Must show to all judges. Champion & Reserve Champion High Points.

Small Fry, L1 Walk/trot - Youth & Amateur, Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, 13 & under, 14-18, Amateur, Select, & Open. Must show halter in your respective halter class. (Small Fry excluded & Walk/trots.) The Novice Youth, 13 & under & 14-18 will receive Academic Scholarships.

Friday - The Royal Feast

How it works – bring a dish to serve in front of your stalls, each 'barn' will have a different course to serve. A printable menu will be available & you can 'graze' the selections while meeting & greeting your fellow exhibitors.
