FLAT RATE - \$240/horse

SEPARATE PAYMENT

Will be required if attending BOTH the SOQHA Challenge AND The Madness.
Be prepared.

Includes all AQHA classes, AQHA Fees & Office Charge Multiple riders - multiple classes. Does **NOT** include stall (s), NSBA classes, shavings, RV or Trail Warm ups.

Entry Fee: \$16/judge/class - OPEN

All other divisions - \$13.00/judge/class

All-Day Fee: \$40/judge - Youth/Amateur/Novice (includes crossovers)

Office Charge - \$5.00 per horse/judge

Walk/Jog: \$10 per class

NSBA Dual/Approved- \$10.00 per class - single judged

Trail Warm Up: \$10.00/horse - Robert Dehn Patterns

AQHA Drug & Processing Fee - \$5.00/horse/show - 4 shows

Small Fry - 9 years & under. \$7.50/class/judge or \$20.00 all day fee. (Per Judge)

Jump Out Fee - \$20/horse/day (those without stalls)

Walk/trot Classes: \$10/judge/class - These are AQHA approved classes. Papers & cards required. NOTE: Per rules - If a horse-rider combination was entered into a Level 1 walk-trot class, that horse-rider combination cannot show in the corresponding loping/cantering class at that show. However, that combination can switch back and forth between the different shows.

Credit Cards will be accepted for entries. A 4% convenience fee will be applied.

Youth Scholarship Challenge

14-18 High Point	Champion: \$1500 Scholarship	Reserve: \$1000 Scholarship

Open to all youth exhibitors, no cost, one horse/one rider.

Must sign up in the office and declare your 3 performance classes and a halter class prior to your first class. Small Fry & Novice Youth are except from showing halter.

May enter multiple divisions, novice and 13 & under, but must sign up for both divisions

9 point scale, based on the number of horses in each class

9 or more horses in the class the winner would get 9 point, 8 for second, etc

9 or less horses, winner gets 1 point for each horse

5 horses = first 5, second 4, third 3 etc

Ties will be broken by the person with the highest placings under the tie breaker judge
